# Key Tasks

- To support the session facilitator with prep work for the artists
- To meet and greet the artists when they arrive
- To proactively contribute to the artistic development of the artists
- To support artists to scan and catalogue their artwork
- To work closely with the session facilitator and artists to prepare for exhibitions
- To support the artists to clean and tidy their area
- To have awareness of the risks within the studio and follow Artbox's control measures to prevent accidents and incidents.
- To attend any volunteer meetings and/or training

### Essential:

- Relevant qualification, ideally in an arts-based subject (degree or advanced professional qualification) or equivalent prior experiential learning
- Interest in developing artists specialist practises
- Desire to work with and support people with learning disabilities and autism
- Able to commit to volunteering on a weekly basis
- Experience of working both independently and collaboratively.
- Knowledge of health and safety policies and procedures.
- Knowledge of safeguarding policies

### Desirable:

- Working within a specialist field of art or design
- Skills in painting, drawing, sculpting, printmaking, animation and/or Adobe Suite
